- G5-M3-L14: Prepare an application problem that is exactly the same as the given Application Problem, using only whole numbers. If students struggle to conceptualize the original problem, project the altered one for them to solve first.
- G5-M3-L15: Word problem lessons can be mentally exhausting. Bolster fluency during these lessons by lengthening the fluency section or interleaving fluency activities throughout the class period.
- G5-M3-L16: If many Ss are struggling with lessons 13-15, consider using this Problem Set as an extension for early finishers throughout this topic.
