T: How many dots?

S: 4.

T: How many empty spaces?

S: 1.

T: **Say the number sentence.**

S: **4 and 1 make 5.**

T: **Flip it.**

S: **1 and 4 make 5.**

GK-M4-L3: Instead of the given Sprint, consider using any of the free Sprints offered on the page below:

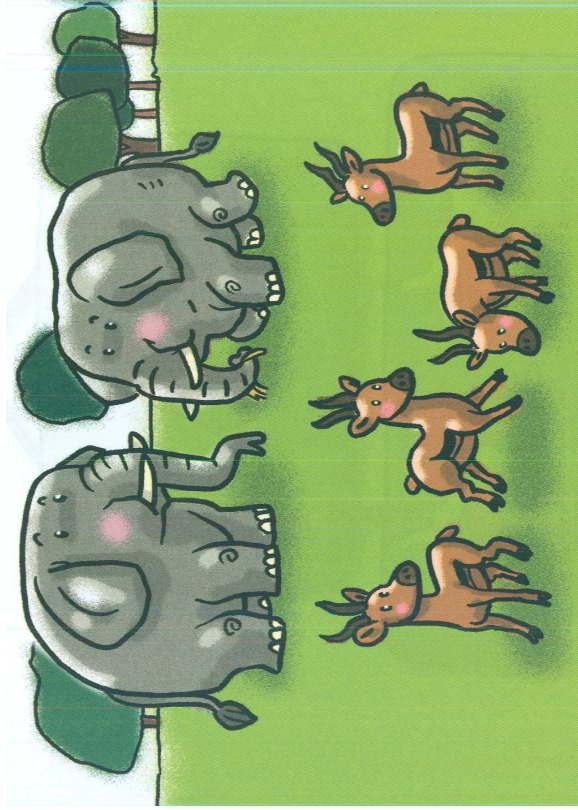

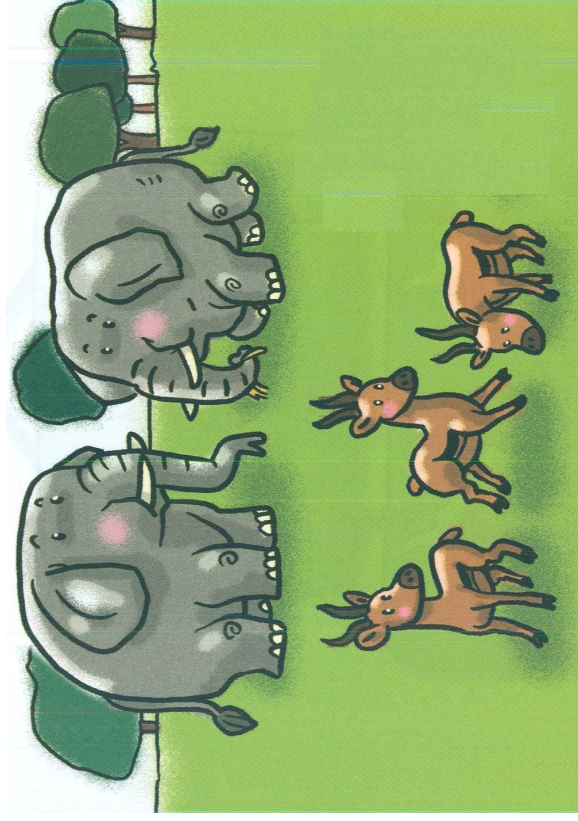
